CMPP

WHAT IS CMPP?

CMPP is a federally-funded program to provide voluntary, trauma-informed, and culturally competent case management and related services to asylum seekers and other noncitizens in ICE Alternatives to Detention Programs.

CMPP services include, among others:

- Pro se legal assistance
- Mental health services
- Human trafficking screening
- Legal and cultural orientations
- Other services that participants identify as priorities
- Departure planning and reintegration services.

CMPP is managed by a National Board chaired by the DHS Officer for CRCL, with other members representing Church World Service, Catholic Charities USA, and The Center for Migration Studies of New York. Church World Service oversees CMPP subrecipients.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Noncitizens enrolled in ICE ATD programs in geographic locations served by CMPP are eligible to participate. Individuals enrolled in FERM, YACMP, or EOIR's dedicated docket are ineligible.
